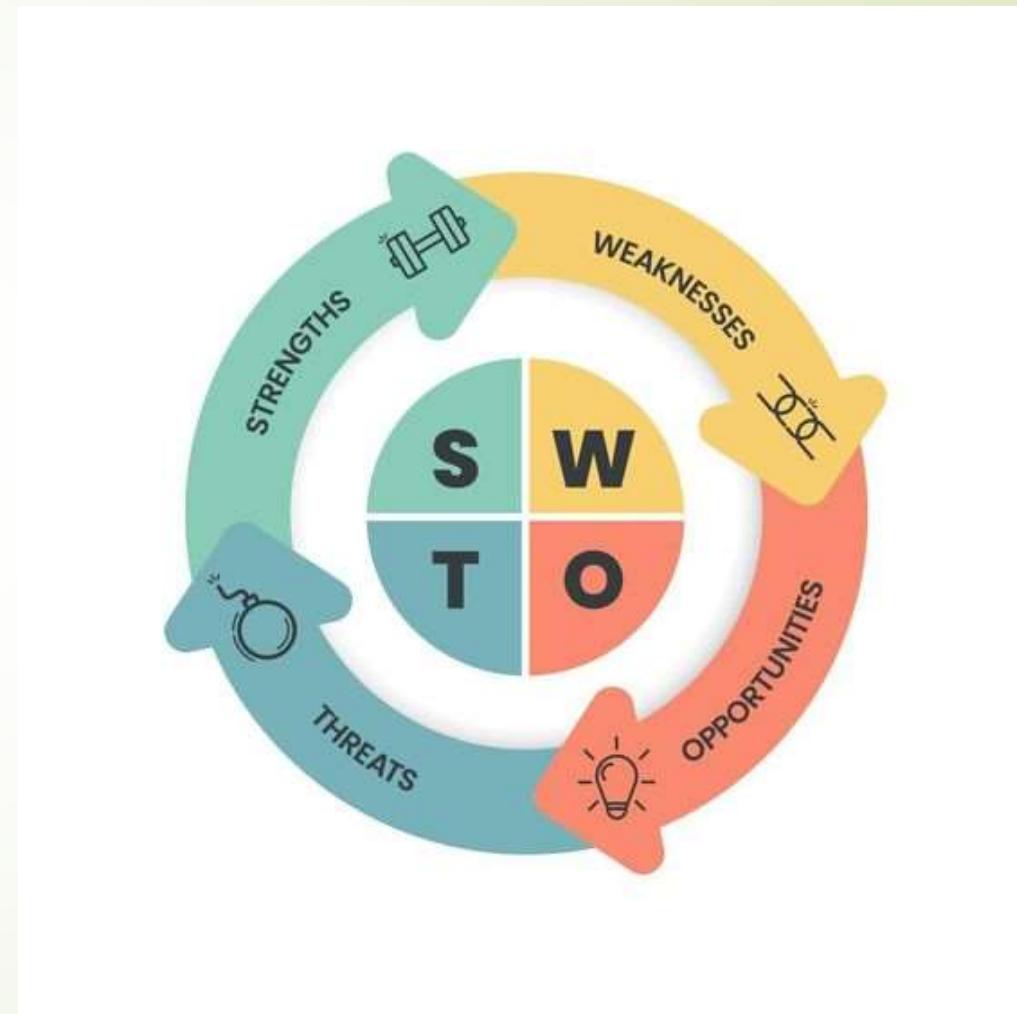
Recommendations based on experience that help
